

## THE GREAT COMMISSION

*Ps 2:8*

*8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.*

*Isa 55:4-5*

*4 See, I have made him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander of the peoples.*

*5 Surely you will summon nations you know not, and nations that do not know you will hasten to you, because of the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has endowed you with splendor."*

*Isa 66:19-20*

*19 "I will set a sign among them, and I will send some of those who survive to the nations.... to the distant islands that have not heard of my fame or seen my glory. They will proclaim my glory among the nations.*

*20 And they will bring all your brothers, from all the nations, to my holy mountain in Jerusalem as an offering to the LORD....*

*Mark 16:15-20*

*15 He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.*

*16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*

*17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."*

*19 After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God.*

*20 Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.*

*Matt 28:18-20*

*18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.*

*19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*

*20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

*Acts 1:8*

*8.....and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

## SALVATION

*John 3:16-18*

*16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

*17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.*

*18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.*

*1 John 3:16-18*

*16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.*

*17 If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him?*

*18 Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth.*

*Rom 10:9-10*

*9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*

*10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.*

*Eph 2:8-10*

*8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-*

*9 not by works, so that no one can boast.*

*10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.*

*1 John 5:12-13*

*12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.*

*13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.*

*1 Tim 2:3-6*

*3 This is good, and pleases God our Savior,*

- 4 who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.  
5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,  
6 who gave himself as a ransom for all men....

#### **SAMPLE PRAYER OF SALVATION:**

**PRAYER: DEAR HEAVENLY FATHER, IN JESUS= NAME I REPENT OF ALL MY SINS AND OPEN MY HEART TO LET JESUS COME INSIDE OF ME. JESUS YOU ARE MY LORD AND SAVIOR. I BELIEVE YOU DIED FOR MY SINS AND YOU WERE RAISED FROM THE DEAD. FILL ME WITH YOUR HOLY SPIRIT. THANK YOU, FATHER FOR SAVING ME IN JESUS= NAME--AMEN.**

### **BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT**

*John 7:37-39*

- 37 On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink.  
38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."  
39 By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

*John 14:16-17*

- 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever-  
17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

*Luke 11:13*

- 13 If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

*Mark 16:15-18*

- 15 He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.  
16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.  
17 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;  
18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

*Acts 1:4-5*

- 4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about.  
5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

*Acts 2:1-4*

- 2:1 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.  
2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.  
3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.  
4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

*Acts 8:14-17*

- 14 When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them.  
15 When they arrived, they prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit,  
16 because the Holy Spirit had not yet come upon any of them; they had simply been baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus.  
17 Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

*Acts 19:1-4*

- 19:1 While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples  
2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."  
3 So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?" "John's baptism," they replied.  
4 Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus."

*Acts 19:6*

- 6 When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied.

**Rom 8:26**

*26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express.*

**1 Cor 14:2**

*2 For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit.*

**1 Cor 14:18**

*18 I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you.*

**Eph 5:18**

*18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.*

**Jude 20**

*20 But you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit.*

**SAMPLE PRAYER TO RECEIVE THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT:**

**PRAYER: FATHER I THANK YOU THAT YOU ARE THE GIVER OF GOOD GIFTS AND IT IS PLEASURE TO GIVE TO ME THE GIFT OF THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT AND IT IS YOUR WILL THAT I RECEIVE THIS GIFT FROM YOU. I THAN YOU THAT WHEN HANDS ARE LAID ON ME I WILL IMMEDIATELY RECEIVE AND I WILL PRAY IN TONGUES AS THE SPIRIT OF GOD ENABLES ME. IN JESUS NAME I PRAY—AMEN**

## **FAITH**

**2 Chron 20:20**

*Have faith in the LORD your God and you will be upheld; have faith in his prophets and you will be successful."*

**1 Chron 28:20**

*"Be strong and courageous, and do the work. Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD God, my God, is with you. He will not fail you or forsake you*

**Mark 11:22-25**

*22 "Have faith in God," Jesus answered.*

*23 "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him.*

*24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.*

*25 And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."*

**Luke 18:8**

*8 I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?"*

**Rom 4:16-21**

*16 Therefore, the promise comes by faith, so that it may be by grace and may be guaranteed to all Abraham's offspring-not only to those who are of the law but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham. He is the father of us all.*

*17 As it is written: "I have made you a father of many nations." He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed-the God who gives life to the dead and calls things that are not as though they were.*

*18 Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, "So shall your offspring be."*

*19 Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead-since he was about a hundred years old-and that Sarah's womb was also dead.*

*20 Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God,*

*21 being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised.*

**Rom 10:17**

*17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.*

**Heb 10:38-11:1**

*38 But my righteous one will live by faith. And if he shrinks back, I will not be pleased with him."*

*39 But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are saved.*

*11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.*

*Heb 11:6*

*6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.*

*1 John 5:4*

*4 for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.*

## HEALING

*Ex 23:25-26*

*25 Worship the LORD your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you, 26 and none will miscarry or be barren in your land. I will give you a full life span.*

*Isa 53:4-5*

*4 Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.*

*Matt 8:16-17*

*16 When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.*

*17 This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."*

*1 Peter 2:24*

*24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.*

*Gal 3:13*

*13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."*

*Ps 103:2-3*

*2 Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits-- 3 who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases,*

*Ps 107:20*

*20 He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.*

*Jer 17:14*

*14 Heal me, O LORD, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise.*

*Jer 30:17*

*17 But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds,' declares the LORD....*

*Rom 8:11*

*11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.*

*Matt 8:2-3*

*2 A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean."*

*3 Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.*

*Acts 10:38*

*38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.*

*3 John 2*

*2 Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well.*

## GUIDANCE

*Ps 32:8-9*

*8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you.*

*9 Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you.*

*Ps 37:4-5*

*Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart.*

*5 Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this:*

*Prov 16:9*

*9 In his heart a man plans his course, but the LORD determines his steps.*

*Isa 2:3*

*"Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths."*

*Ps 103:7*

*7 He made known his ways to Moses, his deeds to the people of Israel:*

*Ps 23:2-3*

*2 He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters,*

*3 he restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.*

*Ps 25:9*

*9 He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.*

*Ps 27:11*

*11 Teach me your way, O LORD; lead me in a straight path because of my oppressors.*

*Ps 31:3*

*3 Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of your name lead and guide me.*

*Ps 48:14*

*14 For this God is our God for ever and ever; he will be our guide even to the end.*

*Isa 30:21*

*21 Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."*

*Isa 42:16*

*16 I will lead the blind by ways they have not known, along unfamiliar paths I will guide them; I will turn the darkness into light before them and make the rough places smooth. These are the things I will do; I will not forsake them.*

*Isa 48:17*

*17 This is what the LORD says-- your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "I am the LORD your God, who teaches you what is best for you, who directs you in the way you should go.*

*Isa 58:11*

*11 The LORD will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail.*

*Prov 3:5-6*

*5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;*

*6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.*

*Prov 4:11-13*

*11 I guide you in the way of wisdom and lead you along straight paths.*

*12 When you walk, your steps will not be hampered; when you run, you will not stumble.*

*13 Hold on to instruction, do not let it go; guard it well, for it is your life.*

*Prov 4:25-27*

*25 Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you.*

*26 Make level paths for your feet and take only ways that are firm.*

*27 Do not swerve to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil.*

*Jer 33:3*

*3'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'*

*Rom 8:14*

*14 because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.*

*John 10:3-5*

*3 The watchman opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.*

*4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.*

*5 But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice."*

*John 16:13*

*13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.*

*James 1:5-8*

*5 If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.*

*6 But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.*

*7 That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord;*

*8 he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.*
